

Other matters to be noted by those applicants who graduated from deemed universities and those applicants who graduated with double main and double Complementaries:

- A. Part I Subject: Normally the Part I language – Marks secured for the Part I Subject (language component)

Part II Subject (Normally the Part II subject is language component)- Marks secured for the Part II Subject (language component)

Part III Subject- $\frac{\sum \text{Credit} \times \text{Grade}}{\sum \text{Credit}}$

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If total CGPA of core course is 9, then the marks out of 100 is $9 \times 10 \times 10$, i.e, 900/1000

- B. Double Main and Double Complementaries:

If the applicant has graduated with double main (eg. Botany & Biotechnology) and intends to apply for M Sc Botany, then enter Botany in the field Core I and Biotechnology in the field Core II and Vice-Versa.

In the case of double complementaries, the CGPA secured for each of them should be added in the following manner:

CGPA secured for Complementary 1 \times Total Credit of Complementary 1 + CGPA secured for Complementary 2 \times Total Credit of Complementary 2

Total Credit of Complementary 1 + Total Credit of Complementary 2

- C. University of Kerala

In the case of those applicants who graduated from University of Kerala, the CGPA and total credit for Foundation course shall be added to that of the vocational /open course in the manner detailed below:

CGPA Secured for Foundation Course \times Total Credit of Foundation Course + CGPA secured for vocational / open course \times Total Credit of Vocational / open course

Total Credit of Foundation Course + Total Credit of Vocational/Open Course

The result so obtained shall be entered against the field vocation/open course
