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PREFACE

Vedanta, the ancient wisdom of India signifies the culmination and ultimate goal of Vedic wisdom, guiding seekers towards the realization of the self and the underlying unity of all creation. It serves as a beacon illuminating the path to self-realization, liberation (moksha), and the understanding of the nature of reality (Brahman). At its core, Vedanta expounds upon the timeless principles of Advaita (non-duality), asserting that the ultimate reality is undivided and indivisible, transcending the apparent multiplicity of the world. Through rigorous inquiry (jñāna), contemplation (dhyana), and devotion (bhakti), Vedanta invites us to unravel the layers of ignorance that veil our true nature, revealing the eternal essence that resides within. It is the most suitable philosophy for creating a world based on compassion.

1. Aim of the Program

This program MGU UGP (Honours) Sanskrit special Vedanta aims to create knowledge of Indian Philosophy especially Vedanta Philosophy ie; Indian Metaphysics among students. Along with the same they will be supplemented with the knowledge on multidisciplinary areas, skill development programmes and value-added courses. A student who successfully completes this program will be able to understand, apply and teach the subject and contribute to the new research areas of Sanskrit Vedanta.

2. Eligibility for Admissions

The student who passed the plus two or equivalent course with any special subject is eligible for admission to this course.

3. Medium of instruction and Assessment

The medium of instruction and assessment for the traditional texts will be Sanskrit. For modern subjects like linguistics, NLP, etc. both Sanskrit and English can be used. In writing Sanskrit Devanagari script should be used.

4. Faculty under which the degree is awarded

5. Specialization offered if any

Specialization in Sanskrit special Vedanta is offered in this course.

Note: On compliance with the UGC minimum standards for the conduct and award of honours Degrees. She/he should be able to do research in a qualifying subject.

6. Program summary

The syllabus under MGU UGP (Honours) for Sanskrit special Vedanta consists of eight semesters. There are One hundred and seventy-seven (177) Credits distributed among these semesters. There are six courses in each semester except the seventh semester. First two semesters have DSC-A,

DSC-B, DSC-C, MDC, AEC-EN, AEC-OL courses. Third and fourth semester include two major DSC -A, DSE, MDC, VAC, DSC-B/ C. There are three DSC - A courses, Two DSE courses and one SEC course in the fifth semester. In the sixth semester three DSC – A, one DSE, SEC and VAC courses are there. In the seventh semester three DSC A, three DSC -B and one MDC courses are there. In eighth semester, Two DSC-A, one MDC, one project or three electives (DSE) are compulsory. There is viva-voce for the project. These will be conducted both externally and internally. The list of external evaluators will be given by the department and the University will take the final decision. The medium of the project should be Sanskrit or English. The examinations – End Semester examinations will be conducted by the university according to its guidelines. The internal evaluation will be done within the college according to the patterns decided by the University.

OUTCOME

- 1) The students who undergo this programme will get a very thorough knowledge of Sanskrit Vedanta, ie; Indian Metaphysics.
- 2) He /She also acquires good knowledge of Sanskrit language and Philosophical ideas.
- 3) He /She gets a very good knowledge of the different Indian philosophical systems.
- 4) He/ She acquires a good knowledge of Philosophy and history of Vedanta.
- 5) He/she will acquire the ability to embrace the moral/ethical values in conducting one's life, social commitments etc.
- 6) He/she will acquire multidisciplinary/ Interdisciplinary knowledge related to the subject.
- 7) He /She will acquire the ability to express their thoughts and ideas effectively in Sanskrit language.

Internship Guidelines and Evaluation :

All the students should undergo an Internship / Apprenticeship in a firm /industry, or training with faculty and researchers in their own institution or other higher education institutions (HEI) during the summer term. Internship has 2 credits and it should be completed in the first three years of FYUGP. The firm / institution from which the student shall undergo internship should be prior- approved by the Department Council, after verifying the quality and genuineness of the firm/institution. The primary goal of the Internship should be enabling the students to actively engage with the practical aspects of their learning and to improve their employability. After the successful completion of the internship, the student has to submit an Internship report to the parent institution Internal mentors shall be assigned to the students for necessary guidance. Online internship can be permitted depending on the nature of the work. The internship shall be 40 to 60 hours duration after the fourth semester. The student shall prepare a Daily Work Record and submit the same to the department periodically as decided by the internal mentor. At the end of the Internship tenure, an Internship Report with the outcomes along with the certificate of attendance shall also be submitted.

The evaluation of the Internship shall be done internally through continuous assessment mode by a committee internally constituted by the Department Council. Project Preparation and Evaluation Guidelines

1. All students shall prepare and submit a project report as part of the Honours programme. The project has to be undertaken on an individual basis and shall be submitted in Semester 8.
2. The general guidelines of the Regulations shall apply for both Internal and External Evaluations of Project Report.
3. The Project shall be done under the supervision and guidance of faculty of the department.
4. Students shall submit the report in the prescribed format at least three weeks before the commencement of the end semester examination of the eighth semester. Internal assessment shall be based on completion of the project, following the norms prescribed in general guidelines.
5. The project work may be Collection and evaluation of data / information or Text based language study / Field Visit Report preparation etc. Translation of literary works to and from Sanskrit is also permissible. Medium of the report should be in Sanskrit (other than translation projects). The project report shall not be less than 40 pages and more than 60 pages including references. The student shall submit

copies of the project report, either printed or typed. The report may be hard bound or soft bound or spirally bound and the printing can be either double sided or single sided. A softcopy of the report shall also be submitted to the department.

6. The report shall contain the following:

Title page with topic, details of the student with register number, supervisor details and month and year of submission.

Certificate from Supervising teacher and counter signed by the Head of the Department with the department seal.

Acknowledgement

Contents

Chapters

Bibliography/References

7. The evaluation of project work shall be done internally through continuous assessment mode by a committee internally constituted by the Department Council. There evaluation shall be awarded by the external examiner appointed by the University. There shall be a viva voce.

8. The scheme of continuous evaluation and the end-semester viva-voce of the Project shall be as given below : –
