The evaluation shall be done by internal examiner(s) as nominated by the department Council/ HoD.  The CO based break up of marks shall be: Project Report and Presentation- 10 marks each for CO1, CO2 and CO3 and 5 marks for CO-4.  Besides, there shall be a viva voce for 15 marks based on all the modules. The marks for viva shall be equally divided among Cos 1, 2 and 3.
