The MGU-UGP Monitoring Committee, after detailed deliberations, submitted recommendations, vide paper read as (7) above, to amend the MGU - UGP (Honours) Regulations, 2024. (Recommendations are attached as Annexure.)

Considering the urgency of the matter, sanction has been accorded by the Vice Chancellor, in exercise of the powers of the Academic Council vested upon him under Section 10(17), Chapter III of the Mahatma Gandhi University Act 1985, vide paper read as (8) above, to approve the recommendations for amendments.

#### 4. Features and Objectives of MGU-UGP

Present	Amendment/Addition
Nil	xlvi) Discipline Specific Core (DSC) courses offered under Pathway Option 1 – Degree Major or Major with Multiple Disciplines of Study – in the first and second semesters will have the same course content and curriculum within a discipline for DSC A, DSC B, and DSC C. The same applies to one DSC course each in Pathway Option 2 – Major with Minor – and Pathway Option 3 – Double Major – for DSC A and DSC B.

#### 9. Duration of Programmes, Credits Requirements and Options

Nil	v) A student admitted to the MGU-UGP (Honours) programme who has completed course registration but was unable to complete exam registration—either due to not meeting the 75% requirement for prescribed classroom activities or for other reasons—can progress to the next semester without meeting any specific credit requirement from the previous semester.
Nil	vi) A student admitted to the MGU-UGP (Honours) programme who has not completed course registration for at least one course in a semester will be required to undergo the readmission process with the following batch of students in the corresponding semester.

Nil	xx) A student admitted to the MGU-UGP (Honours) programme who fails an End Semester Evaluation (ESE) will have the option to reappear in the evaluation process with the following batch of students after paying the specified fee.
Nil	xxi) A student admitted to the MGU-UGP (Honours) programme who fails an End Semester Evaluation (ESE) will have the option to request an Evaluation on Demand (EoD) after paying the specified fee, after the announcement of the semester results.
Nil	xxii) A student admitted to the MGU-UGP (Honours) programme who wishes to improve their marks in an End Semester Evaluation (ESE) will have the option to reappear in the evaluation process with the following batch of students, provided they have not claimed their Bachelor's/ Honours/Honours with Research degree.
